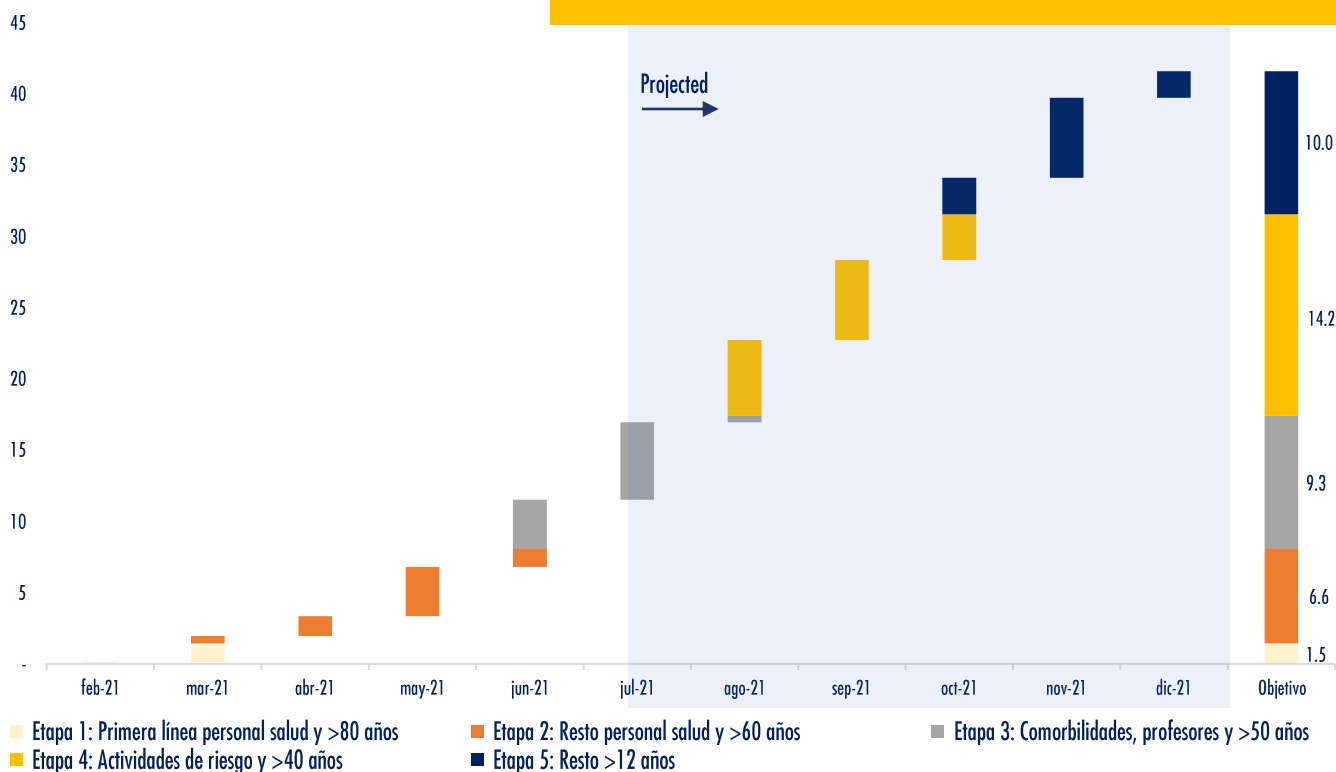

National Vaccination Status

- As of July 7, according to the website of the Ministry of Health, 11 million doses from Pfizer, 10 million from Sinovac, 3 million from Janssen and 2.4 million from AstraZeneca have arrived. Of which 4.3 million doses came through the Covax mechanism.
- As of July 7, the advance in the delivery of vaccines at the national level is at 99.3%, presenting an increase of 12.6% compared to last week.
- On Wednesday, July 7, a record of doses applied was recorded with 438,438.
- As of July 5, 33.8% of the herd¹ population had received at least one dose of the vaccine. This is equivalent to 23.7% of the total population of the country.
- The goal of vaccinated in the National Vaccination Plan rose from 35.7 million people to 41.6 million, which goes from 70% to 81% of the total population of the country.

Taking into account the vaccination rate in recent weeks, of 300,000 daily doses, it would be achieved that in December 2021 the government's goal of fully immunizing 41.6 million Colombians would be met.

ADDITIONALLY, IT WOULD BE ACHIEVED THAT BY OCTOBER 18, **31.6 MILLION PEOPLE HAVE BEEN VACCINATED**, MEETING THE GOVERNMENT'S STAGE 4 GOAL.
